Antiqued Teak Collection

Lloyd Flanders Antiqued Teak is produced from timber obtained solely through FSN sources, primarily in Central and South America. Our partners in China manufacture our product and apply a special finish to give the appearance of aged or reclaimed teak. This finish will eventually silver to the beautiful coloration for which teak is famed.

Caring For Your Antiqued Teak Furniture

Your new teak furniture is easily maintained and only needs periodic cleaning to ensure years of service. First, the teak furniture should be washed down with fresh water. Avoid the use of high pressure or “power washers” as this pressure can affect the surface of the teak. Scrub the wet furniture using a soft bristle brush and a solution of mild detergent and warm water. When finished, rinse the furniture with clean water to remove any detergent.

You may wish to use one of the teak cleaners available at your local home improvement or hardware stores to clean your furniture. If you choose to do so, please follow the instructions on the label to ensure proper cleaning.

Teak furniture may be left out of doors all year. Excessively warm or freezing temperatures will not harm your furniture. If you choose to store your furniture when not in use, it is recommended that the furniture is placed in a dry, unheated space.

Lloyd Flanders Premium Cloud Cushioning

Lloyd Flanders has chosen to offer truly outdoor cushioning on all our casual furniture. Constructed from multiple layers of 100% polyester fiber, the cushions are hydrophobic (drains and dries more easily), hypoallergenic, antimicrobial, and do not mildew. While the Fibers themselves have not changed from our previous all fiber cushioning, our new CLOUD cushioning differs in how the fiber batting is structured, creating just the right balance between comfort and support.

The defining characteristic is in the core, referred to as the inner and outer core. The inner core (providing support) is made from primarily conjugated polyester fiber. Conjugate refers to the three dimensional crimp in the fibers which significantly increases the resiliency of the batting. Due to it's resiliency, conjugated polyester batting has taken the place of polyurethane foam in many applications.

The outer core is silicone-treated "slick" polyester batting. Sandwiched between the outer wrap and the conjugated inner core, this layer is responsible for the "soft landing" prior to sinking through to the support of the inner core, greatly enhancing the comfort of the seat.

Caring For Lloyd Flanders New Cloud Cushioning

Cushions upholstered in Sunbrella® or other solution dyed acrylic fabrics may be cleaned with one cup of chlorine bleach diluted in one gallon of water with a small amount of mild detergent . Test in a small inconspicuous area. Saturate a cloth or soft brush with the solution. Scrub the entire cushion and rinse well with clean water and let air dry.

Printed acrylic fabric may be scrubbed with a solution of mild detergent and warm water. Do not use bleach. Rinse and air dry. Do Not Put In Dryer Or Send Out To Dry Cleaners.

If excessive waters accumulates in the cushion, stand upright with the open zipper or seam side down. The cushion should dry quickly as this facilitates the draining of the water through the fibers.

Caring For Lloyd Loom Casual Furniture

Lloyd Flanders All Weather Wicker will remain beautiful with minimal care and maintenance.

Regularly, vacuum the wicker and cushions with a soft brush or upholstery tool to remove organic material and surface soil. If they do become soiled, both the frame and the wicker can be washed with a mild detergent and water. Please use a wet sponge or soft brush to clean the soil from the surface. Rinse with clear water and dry thoroughly before use.

As with any fine outdoor furniture, timely care of the paint finish is necessary to protect the furniture from the elements and preserve its strength and beauty. If the wicker finish becomes worn, carefully clean and dry the affected area. Repaint with Lloyd Flanders touch-up paint. Allow to dry thoroughly before use.

If the finish on the frame becomes scratched or chipped, first, lightly sand the problem area with fine grit sandpaper. Clean and dry the area, then use Lloyd Flanders touch-up paint.

Caring For Lloyd Flanders Woven Vinyl Casual Furniture

Lloyd Flanders uses only premium Polyethylene woven materials for our luxury outdoor furniture. While this material is designed to endure the outdoor environment, it is beneficial to make sure the product is cleaned and maintained for your ultimate satisfaction.

Vacuum or use a soft brush on woven material and cushions to remove organic material and loosen surface soil. Wash with a mild detergent and clean water solution to remove soil. Rinse and allow to dry thoroughly before use.
